VISION -> COLLECTIVE ACTION IN PRACTICE

- > 359 CLTs in England and Wales
- > 1,885 homes in ownership
- Also 100+ green space, workspace, community centres, shops, etc.
- > 7,000+ assets in development

OUR AMBITION





With the right policy and industry support, the CLT movement could take replicable products to scale, building 278,000 CLT homes. 80% of these homes are additional, they wouldn't be built without the CLT.

The opportunities:

30,000 homes on rural exception sites delivered in partnership with housing associations.

20,000 homes using portions of large sites, whether urban regeneration or greenfield garden villages.

117,000 homes on larger community led housing exception sites in partnership with developers.

33,000 homes in urban infill sites.

778k 150 new CLTs forming across cities and towns across the country to deliver 500 homes each - 78,000 in total.

HOW? DIY PROJECTS E.G. BEER CLT (DEVON)

COMMUNITY LAND TRUST NETWORK

Started in 2013 by local District Councillor

Develops and manages own homes, borrows via district council

13 affordable homes in two small schemes, assets of £2m

A Registered Provider







CLT owns land, controls location, design & allocations

HA builds & manages homes, pays ground rent to CLT

No Right to Buy, Right to Shared Ownership

Less work & responsibility for community



HOW? DEVELOPER PARTNERSHIPS E.G. NEWTON & NOSS CLT



125 homes, 46% affordable, 18 social rented to CLT

Developer finances and builds, CLT jointly leads community engagement and scheme design

CLT partnered with HA to manage homes (but could be landlord itself)
